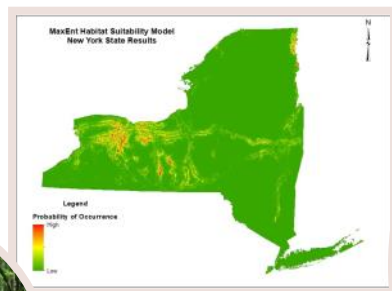
Past internship projects have included:
